

Election Security & Transparency

Dr. Nizam Razack supports President Trump's strong, commonsense election reforms designed to protect every lawful American vote, restore public confidence, and ensure elections are secure, transparent, auditable, and free from fraud, corruption, or foreign interference.

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Dr. Razack's supports President Trump's Election Integrity Priorities:

1. Verified U.S. Citizen Voting

Require proof of U.S. citizenship for voter registration and maintain accurate voter rolls to ensure only eligible citizens participate in American elections.

2. Secure Paper Ballots

Require hand-marked paper ballots printed on secure, non-reproducible paper produced by U.S.-based vendors. Limit electronic systems except where required for ADA compliance.

3. Election Day Voting with Photo ID

Restore a single designated Election Day with valid government-issued photo identification required for every ballot cast.

4. Limit Mass Mail-In Voting

End universal mass mail-in ballot programs and restrict absentee voting to military personnel, first responders, disabled citizens, and medically qualified elderly voters with strict chain-of-custody protections.

5. Transparent Hand Counting & Oversight

Require ballot counting procedures that include bipartisan oversight, public observation, documented safeguards, and transparent reporting standards.

6. Civic Engagement & Election Education

Allow trained high school and college students to assist with election administration and ballot review for civic education credit, helping restore confidence and participation in the democratic process.

7. American-Made Election Systems

Require all election technology, software, and equipment to be manufactured, certified, maintained, and secured in the United States with regular independent security audits.

8. Fully Auditable Elections

Ensure every stage of the election process is documented, reviewable, and subject to audit procedures when irregularities or concerns arise.

9. Reduce Election Waste & Bureaucracy

Lower taxpayer costs by simplifying election operations, reducing dependence on expensive voting systems, and eliminating unnecessary mass mail-ballot programs.
