

Fiscal Responsibility, Government Accountability & Debt Reduction

Dr. Razack believes America's exploding national debt is a direct threat to our economic stability, national security, and the future of our children and grandchildren.

Washington cannot continue spending money it does not have while burdening future generations with unsustainable debt, inflation, and weakened economic growth.

Fiscal responsibility begins with eliminating waste, fraud, abuse, corruption, and reckless spending at every level of government.

Key Provisions

1. Aggressively Eliminate Government Fraud

Launch comprehensive audits and investigations targeting fraud, waste, abuse, and improper payments across all federal agencies and federally funded programs. Taxpayer dollars are not monopoly money.

2. Full Transparency & Public Accountability

Require transparent public reporting of federal expenditures, contracts, grants, earmarks, and agency spending in a searchable and understandable format accessible to the American people.

3. Zero-Based Budgeting

Require federal agencies to justify spending from the ground up rather than automatically increasing budgets year after year regardless of performance.

4. Strengthen Inspector General Oversight

Expand the authority, independence, and enforcement powers of Inspectors General to investigate corruption, procurement fraud, misuse of taxpayer funds, and bureaucratic abuse.

5. Modernize Government Operations

Implement modern technology, competitive bidding, and efficiency reforms to reduce administrative waste, duplication, and bloated bureaucracy.

6. Recover Stolen & Misused Funds

Pursue aggressive recovery of taxpayer funds lost through fraud, improper payments, foreign scams, pandemic abuse programs, and government contracting misconduct.

7. End Reckless Deficit Spending

Support responsible budgeting practices that prioritize essential national functions while reducing unnecessary spending and long-term debt obligations.

8. Audit Federal Programs for Effectiveness

Require regular performance reviews of federal programs to determine:

- Whether programs work
- Whether objectives are being met
- Whether duplication exists
- Whether programs should be reformed or eliminated

9. Ban Congressional Self-Enrichment

Support strict ethics reforms prohibiting elected officials from financially benefiting from privileged government access, insider knowledge, or influence.

10. Protect Future Generations

Recognize that uncontrolled debt weakens the dollar, fuels inflation, increases interest costs, threatens retirement security, and places enormous burdens on future Americans.

Dr. Razack believes government should operate the same way hardworking American families and businesses do: responsibly, transparently, and within reason. The answer is not higher taxes and bigger bureaucracy.

The answer is accountability, efficiency, economic growth, and ending the culture of waste and fraud in Washington.
