Dr. Razack's AI & Child Protection Priorities

1. Put Children First

2. Ban Unauthorized Collection of Children's Data

Violators should face severe civil penalties, criminal liability, and potential loss of operating privileges.

3. Require Strong Content Safeguards

Mandate aggressive filtering and moderation protections to prevent minors from exposure to:

- Sexual exploitation
- Graphic violence
- Predatory content
- Drug-related material
- Self-harm promotion
- Psychological manipulation
- Radicalization and extremist targeting
- AI-generated deception or impersonation

Parents deserve full transparency regarding how AI systems:

- Recommend content
- Filter information
- Collect behavioral data
- Generate responses
- Influence children online

4. Crack Down on Online Predators & Exploitation

Require AI providers to deploy advanced monitoring and detection systems capable of identifying:
