4. Prescription Drug Accountability

Expose hidden pharmaceutical pricing schemes and Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) abuses that drive up medication costs.

5. Reduce Federal Healthcare Bureaucracy

Cut unnecessary regulations and administrative burdens that increase costs and contribute to physician burnout.

6. Protect Doctor-Patient Decision Making

Medical decisions belong between patients and doctors not politicians, corporate algorithms, or insurance executives.

7. Expand Rural & Community Healthcare Access

Support incentives for physicians, specialists, urgent care centers, and emergency facilities to serve underserved communities.

8. Promote Preventive Care & Wellness

Encourage preventive medicine, nutrition education, and early screenings to improve outcomes and reduce long-term healthcare costs.

Protect patients' rights to informed consent and transparent healthcare decisions.
